



Aircombat at Rembo RC 15-16th August



ACES Sweden invites you to a Euro cup located at Rembo RC model flying club, in the vicinity of the small city Avesta in Sweden. It will be a solid competition divided into two days, Saturday (15th) and Sunday (16th). All pilots need to register their participation to ACES Sweden no later than August 5th. On Saturday night there will be a pilot´s party at the airfield, a catering firm will organize a barbeque for those who want food at the party.

Registration

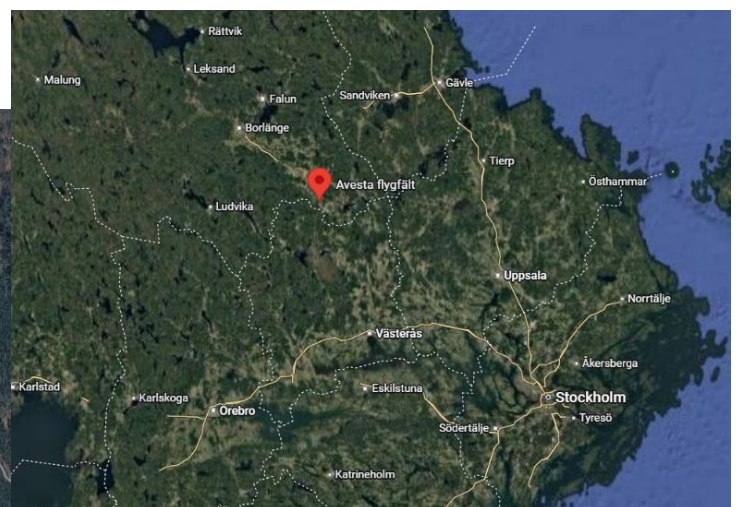
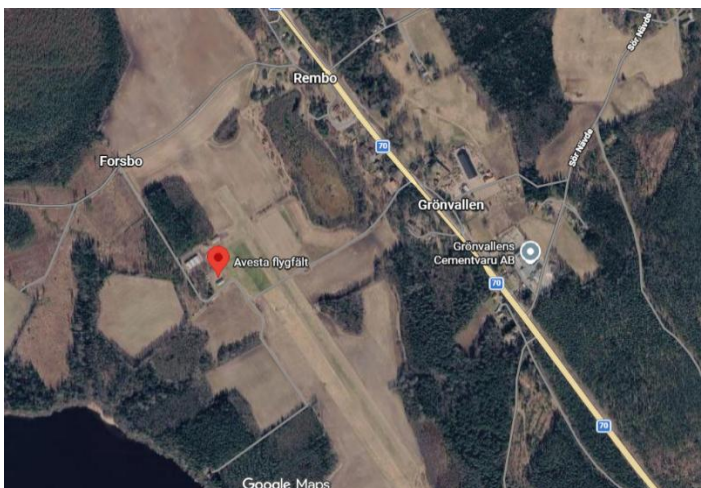
You register your participation via email to: info@aircombat.se – write to us in which classes you want to compete, on what day you will arrive to the airfield and inform us if you will use tent, caravan or a camper at the airfield. Also inform us if you would like food at the pilot´s party on Saturday night, we need to know this in advance so we know how many portions we should order for the pilot-party. You will pay for the food for the pilot´s party on site; the price is not known yet.

Location

Rembo RC flying club is located circa 7 km north-west of the small city Avesta. Avesta airfield or “Avesta flygfält” (*in Swedish*), is both a full-scale airfield and a model flying airfield. If you type in “Avesta flygfält” into Google maps you will get the exact location for the airfield where the competition will be hosted.

Avesta airfield is located circa 670 km north of Malmö. The red dot marks the exact location for the airfield.



NOTE: Since it is also a full-scale airfield, there can also be full-scale airplanes that make take-offs and landings at the airfield during the competition, we must show regard to this and be prepared to adapt our flying according to the real airplane's motions, more information about this will be shared to all pilots on site.

Camping

It is possible to camp at the airfield from Thursday (13th) to Sunday (16th). There will be a camping fee per night that you need to pay at site to the model flying club, the camping fee is 150 kronor or 15 euro per night.

There is 220 V electricity at the airfield so you can charge batteries and also use for electricity in caravans (not for heating caravans). There are both WC: s, showers and drinkable water available at the airfield. There is plenty of space at the airfield for setting up both tents, caravans or campers. The model flying club also has 4-5 beds in the clubhouse that you can rent if you don't have tents or caravans.

There is also a hangar at the airfield where we can store our models during the nights.

Contact

Food

Rembo RC will serve hamburgers, drinks and coffee which you can buy both on Saturday and Sunday during the competition. On Saturday night the club organizes a barbeque for those who want. For the barbeque you need to bring your own drinks. The barbeque cost is not set yet; you pay for the barbecue food on site. Please also inform us in advance via mail if you have any allergies for the pilot's party!

Classes

-WW1 class (3 heats + final). Starting fee is 150 kronor or 15 euro/pilot (half price for youths).

-WW2 class (5 heats + final). Starting fee is 150 kronor or 15 euro/pilot (half price for youths).

Payment

You pay the starting fees to ACES Sweden´s bank account, you need to do this before the competition starts. Our bank account has the following numbers:

-WW1 starting fee is 15 euros

-WW2 starting fee is 15 euros

Rules

-During the competition we will use international rules for both classes WW1 and WW2.

-All pilots need to have a valid registered operation-ID according to EASA-rules during the contest, you should be able to show this ID on site.

-All pilots also need to be covered by insurance via their own country's model-flying association.

-All pilots need to be able to show a valid competition license from their own country. (You don´t need to buy a Swedish competition license as long as you have one from your own country).

Schedule

Thursday 13th

-From 17:00 pilots are welcome to camp at the airfield.

Saturday 15th

-Pilot briefing begins at 10:00.

-First rounds of WW1 start at 11:00.

-Lunch break circa 12:30 – 13:15.

-First rounds of WW2 start at 13:15 and continue to circa 17:00.

-Pilot party begins circa 19:00 at the airfield, bring your own drinks to the party and the model flying club organizes the food.

Sunday 16th

- Pilot briefing begins at 09:30.
- Remaining WW1-rounds begin at 10:00.
- Remaining WW2-rounds begin at 11:00 – 12:30.
- Lunch break circa 12:30 – 13:00
- Remaining WW2-rounds continue at 13:00 to circa 14:00.
- WW1-final begins at circa 14:15.
- WW2-final begins at circa 14:45.
- Price ceremony begins at circa 15:30.
